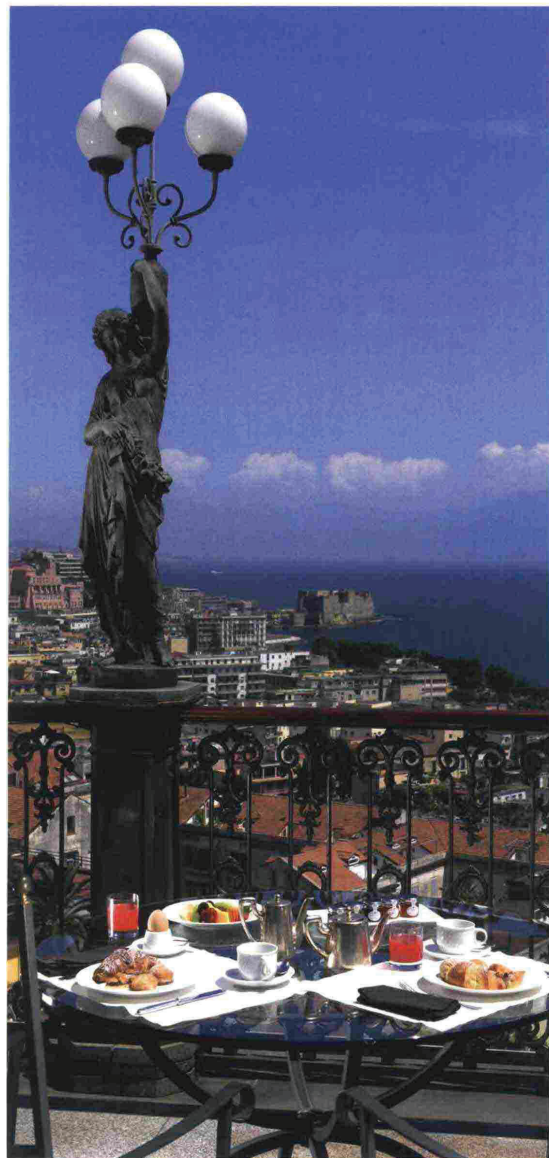
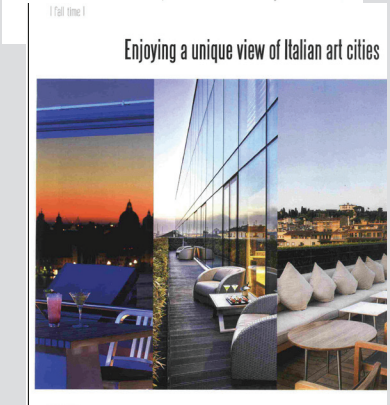

Not forgetting the fact that Grand Hotel Parker's is the first and only hotel in Naples to gain Kosher certification. It also hosts Life Life, a space dedicated to regaining physical, mental and spiritual fitness, where guests can indulge in some totally natural relaxation.
