NAPLES

Since 1870 the five-star luxury Grand Hotel Parker's in Naples has been an icon of charm and hospitality, and now it introduces George, its new gourmet restaurant. Awarded one Michelin star in the 2020 edition of the guide, it is named after the English marine biologist George Parker Bidder. In the late 19th century Bidder took over ownership of the Tramontano, transforming it in a grand hotel that now bears his name. The underlying concept in the kitchen and interiors is entirely new after a restyling by the Studio Pisani Morace of Naples, which is giving the hotel a face lift without compromising the building's timeless charm. Silk velvet, slate and black marble, moiré-effect wallpaper and bronze leaf surfaces enrich the new George's interiors. Its wide windows open onto the terrace, which provides a stunning night-time view of the Bay of Naples. The young kitchen team, average age thirty, is led by Neapolitan chef Domenico Candela, born in 1986. He returned from France to take the helm at the George. Next to the restaurant is the Krug Lounge, the ideal venue for an aperitif with a view, a glass of Champagne or an after-dinner liqueur.



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
